SUMMER TRAVELING BASEBALL 2010 SENIOR DIVISION -- 7th-12th GRADES

Tryouts for Fair Lawn All-Sports' 2010 summer traveling baseball teams for 7th-12th graders will be held at the Dobrow Sports Complex on Harristown Road in the spring. Once finalized, the dates, times, and locations of the tryouts will be posted on the baseball page of the All-Sports website, www.fallsports.org. E-mails will be sent by Fair Lawn All-Sports to all baseball registrants once the summer tryout schedule is set.

- The number of summer traveling teams for each school grade (based on the player's grade during the 2009-10 school year) will be determined based upon turnout and performance at these tryouts.
- ***To be selected for any grade's summer traveling team, a player must attend at least one tryout for that grade, and each player can only try out for the team representing their own grade.***
- All selected players will be required to provide a copy of their birth certificate and pay a registration fee of \$175 by the team's first practice, with checks payable to "Fair Lawn All-Sports". This fee covers the players' uniforms, their team's registration for one league, and one additional tournament, as well as the cost of umpires and equipment.
- Summer traveling teams will begin practicing soon after their selection (avoiding conflicts with our Chuck O'Connor program), and will have practices and games at least three days a week from early June through mid July. Parents/guardians should be prepared at tryouts to alert the coaches to any vacation plans or other potential conflicts with that schedule.

April 30th is the date as of which players' ages for summer traveling baseball are determined. For players in 7th grade or above and born before May 1, 1997, teams are based on school grade. as shown below:

<i><u>If you are currently in...</u></i>	<i><u>...you are eligible to try out for our summer team for...</u></i>
7th grade	7th graders (under age 14)
8th grade	8th graders (under age 15)
9th or 10th grade	9th and 10th graders (under age 17)
11th or 12th grade	11th and 12th graders (under age 19)
