GIRLS SOFTBALL PROGRAM – 2012

SOFTBALL CLINIC – Grade: Kindergarten

This group instructional program starts on Saturday, April 7th and will continue every Saturday from 9 to 11am thru June 9th at the Warren Point Annex. Players receive a hat and t-shirt.

The goal of this program is to introduce the proper mechanics of fielding, throwing, hitting and base running to young players through group instruction. The program will focus on basic drills to develop the fundamentals for softball. Teams are not formed.

INSTRUCTIONAL SOFTBALL LEAGUE – Grades 1 & 2

This program starts on Saturday, April 7th and continues thru Saturday, June 9th. Practice/Games held on Tuesdays from 6 to 8pm and Saturdays from 11am - 1pm. Players are assigned to teams. Players receive a hat, t-shirt and game pants.

The goal of this instructional program is to develop basic softball skills such as fielding, hitting, throwing and base running through practice and non-competitive league play. Players will be introduced to pitching mechanics although the coaches will pitch to their players in games.

INTERMEDIATE SOFTBALL LEAGUE – Grades 3 & 4

This program starts on Saturday, April 7th and continues thru Saturday, June 9th. Practice/Games held on most Tuesdays & Thursdays from 6 - 8pm and Saturdays from 1 – 3pm. Players are assigned to teams. Players receive a visor, t-shirt and game pants.

The goal of this modified competitive program is to provide players the opportunity to further develop their skills and understanding of the game. Emphasis is on basic skills and the players pitch in games.

JUNIOR SOFTBALL LEAGUE – Grades 5 & 6

EVALUATION DATE: Saturday, March 10th, 9am – 11am at Memorial Middle School gym [for all 5th graders and new 6th graders to the league].

This program begins the week of March 12th and continues thru June 9th . Regular season games are on Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays from 6 – 8pm. Players receive a visor, t-shirt & shorts.

This competitive program is geared to further player and team skill levels. New players are drafted at the "Evaluation" date above. Requests cannot be honored. Teams will compete and results are posted. League & playoff championships held. **In the event a new team is added or subtracted all teams will retain one head coach and the entire league will be completely redrafted.**

SENIOR SOFTBALL LEAGUE – Grades 7, 8 & 9

*EVALUATION DATE: Saturday, March 10th, 12:00am – 2:00pm at Memorial Middle School gym [for all 7th graders and new 8th/9th graders to the league]. This program begins the week of March 12th and continues thru June 9th. **Regular season games are on weeknights after 7pm and as previous years may include some traveling to play other towns.** Players receive a visor, t-shirt & shorts.*

This competitive program is geared to further player and team skill levels. New players are drafted at the "Evaluation" date above. Requests cannot be honored. Teams will compete and results are posted. League & playoff championships held. **In the event a new team is added or subtracted all teams will retain one head coach and the entire league will be completely redrafted.**
